

How to choose a topic




- Look at the Bird Eye View of Seerah
 (http://www.fussilat.com/bev-seerah/downloads)
- Find an event or incident from Seerah that interests you.
- Study the topic in detail from the provided references and through other authentic resources.
- Write key points of the event, make sure you choose the details to the extent you will be able to present in 8-10 min.
- Think of a good title for the topic.
- Write a good summary of the topic.

How to Enter?



- Before the deadline (Jan 14, 2024), please submit your abstract to via this link
 (https://drive.google.com/file/d/1BjqS-T7UsjBcLQgf2 ILin2EVzt rmmV/view?usp=sharing)
- All abstracts are collected and reviewed by the organizing team.
- The organizing technical team will review the abstracts for the contents to be presented at the conference.
- The selected speakers will be notified by email on or before **Jan 16, 2024**, and presentation preparation guidelines will be sent subsequently.



Abstracts



• Abstract should be in the form of videos



Abstract Criteria



- Speakers are encouraged to prepare abstracts on the topics they are passionate about. However, to ensure that the abstract has the potential for gaining acceptance, the topic must meet the following requirements:
 - The topic should be related to the Seerah of the Prophet
 - The topic should be one of our key focus that will create an impact on audience.
 - The information presented must come from authentic sources.
 - The content must include sufficient information for reviewers to evaluate the nature and significance of the topic
 - The video abstract run time should be between 2-3 minutes.
 - Note that the selected speakers will be given about 8-10 minutes to speak on the conference day, so prepare the abstract accordingly.


- Once you prepare abstract, you should record yourself in a video format
